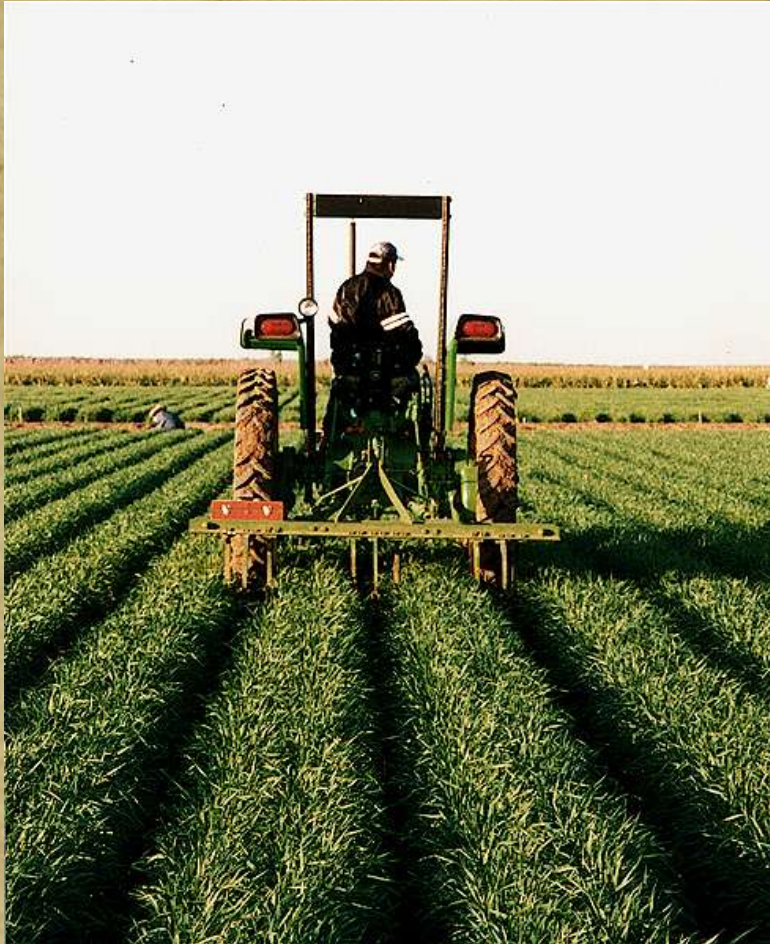

the bushes

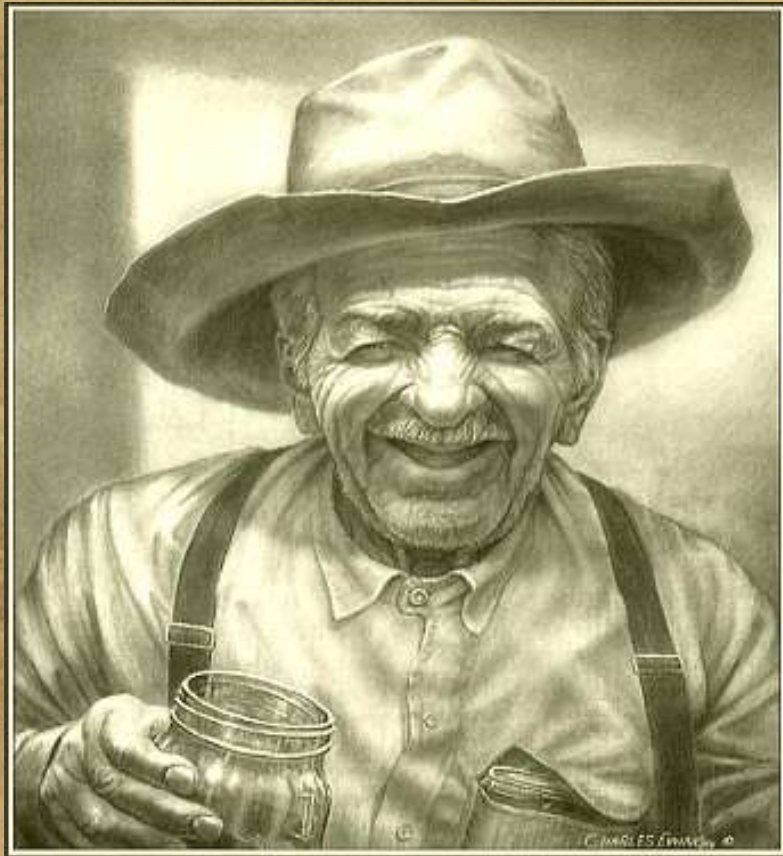
she went closer and...
